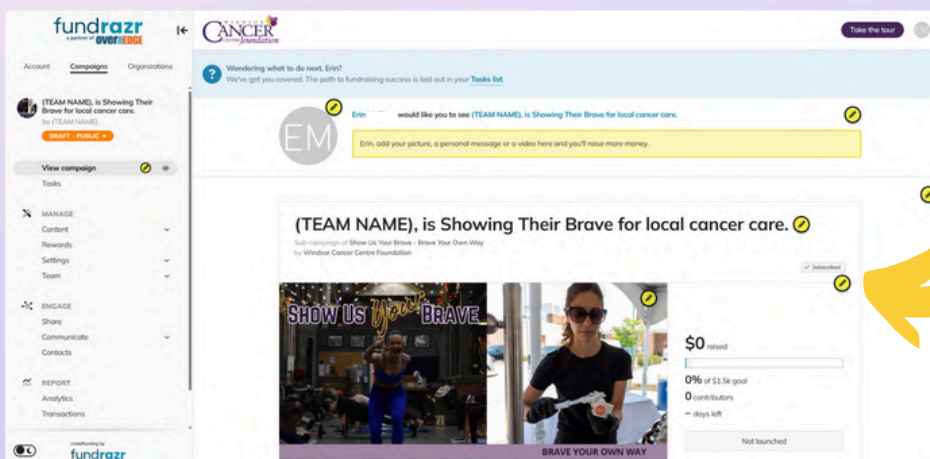
3 **CREATE** your profile on Fundrazr, the official fundraising platform for Show Us Your Brave.

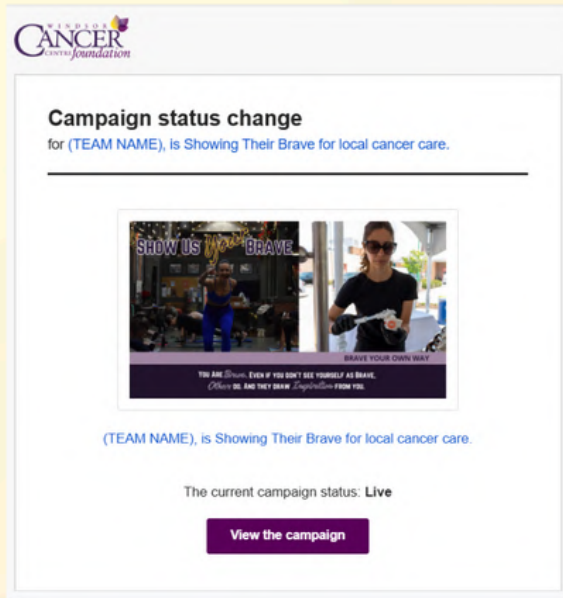

6 **STORYTIME!** In the Story section, be sure to add your photo and share your “why” with the world.

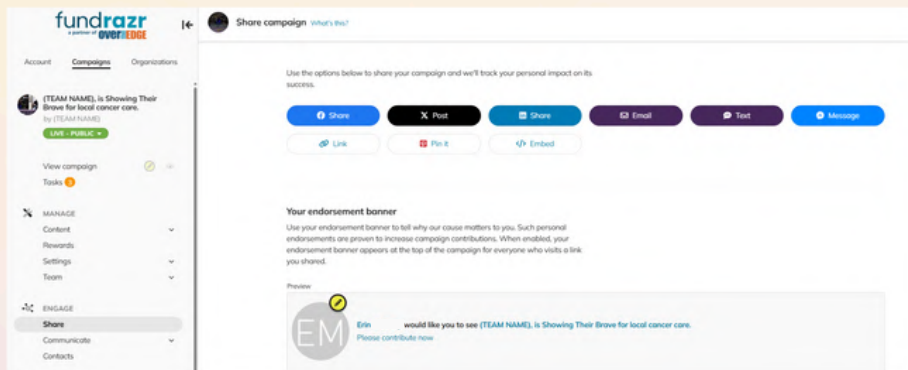
7 **PUBLISH YOUR WORK** Review and launch your Brave Your Own Way campaign in support of cancer patients in our community.
